MOUNT OLIVE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION District-Owned Electronic Device Protocol for Damage, Theft or Loss

The Mount Olive Township Board of Education has purchased electronic devices such as computers and tablets for the use of the students. The following requirements must be followed should the device given to a student be damaged, stolen or lost:

- 1. If damage, theft or loss of the electronic device occurs, the student must immediately notify administration;
- 2. If the device has any technical issues, the device must be brought to the administration so that Technology Support can be contacted'
- 3. Any hardware/software repairs that are not due to misuse or damage will be covered without cost; however any accidental or intentional damage to the device may incur a cost;
- 4. Fines will be imposed in accordance with the chart below or as circumstances may warrant at the discretion of administration;
- 5. After two incidents of accidental damage, the student may lose some privilege which may also result in disciplinary action;
- 6. All reports are to be investigated and addressed on a case-by-case basis.
